Type: Full-time (37.5 hours per week) – Exempt

About this position:

The Ohio River Valley Coordinator will monitor and analyze data associated with oil, gas, and petrochemical activities in the Ohio River Valley and nationally, and collaborate with partner organizations to apply these findings to strategic regional campaigns and initiatives that further the transition away from fossil fuels.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Collect and manage relevant environmental, health, and crowdsourced data
- Collaborate with local, regional, and national organizations to further strategic campaigns and initiatives
- Participate in regional and national coalitions such as People Over Petro Coalition, the Breathe Collaborative, and Break Free From Plastic
- Raise awareness about the impacts of fossil fuel activities in the Ohio River Valley and work towards sustainable and responsible energy practices in the region
- Support frontline communities through providing customized maps, data, and analyses, attending
 and organizing training and convenings, and speaking at local forums. Occasionally this may include
 communities in the Gulf South, Permian Basin, or other regions.
 - Respond to service requests from partner organizations, members of the media, public officials, researchers, and other audiences



- Present FracTracker's findings to a variety of audiences through webinars, public speaking events, etc.
 - Coordinate with other FracTracker regional offices to share information and lessons learned
- Regularly author reports, articles, story maps, and other content to be published on the FracTracker website
- Coordinate with Manager of Data and Technology and/or regional coordinators to maintain and/or prepare applicable maps and data for reference on FracTracker.org
- Promote FracTracker's mobile and web applications and provide training in-person and online to front line communities and organizations about the use of these technologies
- Periodically supervise volunteers and interns
- Assist in updating and developing digital and printable training tools, guides, and tutorials on various topics of interest to our clients and website visitors
- Assist with grant reporting, as needed
- Other duties as assigned
